

Grown-Ups - Here's How You Can Help

Buckleburgh Bound is designed to be played together. Children don't need to read everything or know all the rules — your role is to guide, encourage, and join in the fun.

You Can Help By:

- Reading the rules aloud
- Helping children take turns and roll the dice
- Asking gentle questions like:
 - “What do you think happens next?”
 - “Who might need this item?”
- Helping with cutting out pieces or setting up the map
- Encourage Storytelling
- There are no right or wrong answers in Buckleburgh. If a child wants to change the rules, invent a character, or tell the story a different way — that's part of the magic.
- Keep It Light
- If attention drifts, pause the game.

You can:

- Play for just a few turns
- Finish the story another day
- Turn a single move into a whole tale
