**What is a Fable? A fable is a story that teaches a lesson (moral)**

Example - The Tortoise and the Hare

The Story (Very Short)

A fast hare laughs at a slow tortoise.

They race. The hare runs ahead and naps.

The tortoise keeps going... and wins!

## Main Moral

Slow and steady wins the race.

Big Lesson About Judgment

- Don't judge others by how they look or move
- Being slow doesn't mean being weak
- Staying patient and trying your best matters
